This unit of competency will provide you with the essential WHS/OHS knowledge and skills to work safely in a range of construction sites. The unit is a WorkSafe Victoria mandatory requirement for any person entering or working on a building or construction site.

### Course Entry Requirements

Course applicants must meet the following selection criteria:

- minimum 16 years at course commencement
- satisfactory completion of Year 9 secondary school studies or higher, and
- satisfactory completion of a language, literacy and numeracy test.

## Training and assessment methods, and location

### Scheduled Classes:

The course will be conducted at Parade College, Bundoora Campus. Training methods include face to face, classroom based trainer led presentations and demonstrations. Students will have significant opportunities to develop practical skills in work health and safety with trainer coaching and supervision.

During the course you will also have the opportunity to apply your work health and safety knowledge and skills via practical projects. These sessions will be conducted at the College's onsite training facilities.

### Assessment:

A range of assessment methods are used throughout the course including workbook activities, written tests and practical skill demonstrations. You will receive detailed assessment information on commencement of each unit.

During orientation you will be informed of any specialist clothing, footwear, equipment or materials required of the course.
