

### **English**

- ► The "standard" English
- Builds on what you've been doing for the past three-and-a-half years
- Includes the following tasks
  - ► Text response essays
  - Creative writing
  - Persuasive writing
  - Argument and language analysis


#### English as an Additional Language (EAL)

- ▶ There are strict entry requirements for EAL.
  - For example, EAL students must have migrated to Australia <u>less than seven years ago</u> and their previous schooling (eg. primary school) will have been in another language.
- We have lists of students who qualify.
- If you believe you may qualify, please see me.


- You can expect to read:

- You will also study a film


