Students who enroll in the course should understand that it is a two-year program within the VCE VM. Further, that excluding the General Achievement Test (GAT) in Yr 12, it does not involve externally scored assessments (i.e., examinations), and the subjects or course will not contribute to an ATAR score.

## Note:

- The program also incorporates structured workplace learning and enrolment in the relevant VET subjects.
- VET classes may be timetabled to commence before (i.e. 7:30 am) and/or conclude after regular school hours (i.e. 5:00 pm). Attendance during these times is required. Confirmation of times will be made available once timetables are released.
- The College does not offer the option for students that have commenced the VCE VM Sport Academy to change to the VCE or to change the campus that they are enrolled at as part of the Sport Academy.
