FEE DISCOUNTS

FAMILY DISCOUNT

Fees are charged on a per student basis with discounted rates applicable to families with two or more students attending Parade College concurrently. Families with two or more students enrolled at Parade College will receive the following reduction on Tuition Fees:

- 10% discount for second child
- 50% discount for third child
- 100% discount for fourth child

*The discount applies to the tuition fee only

EARLY PAYMENT DISCOUNT

Payment in full by Friday 5 December 2025 -6% discount deducted from the Tuition Fee and Charter Bus (if applicable)

MUSIC LESSONS

The Parade College Music Department has a longstanding history of providing students with a large variety of musical experiences, and our music program is renowned for the wide range of opportunities it offers students, both in private tuition and in various ensembles.

Instrumental Music Lessons are scheduled so that they rotate through the student's normal weekly timetable. Classes at Parade College operate on a 6 period a day, twoweek timetable. Students are expected to catch up on work covered in their academic class.

All lessons are either 25 minutes (1/2 a lesson) or 50 minutes (full lesson) in duration. It is recommended those students studying VCE Music Performance or sitting AMEB Grade 5 and above have 50-minute lessons after consultation with their teacher.

*Please note: Group lessons are only available for Brass & Woodwind students in Years 7 - 9.

BUSES

There is safe, convenient and easy access via PTV and Charter bus services. PTV public buses and trams also stop at the entrance to Parade College.

PTV BUSES

PTV buses are operated on behalf of the State Government Public Transport Victoria. They are for the exclusive use of Parade students. There is no guarantee of a seat on a PTV bus as it is part of the public transport network. Students pay using MYKI card.

CHARTER BUSES

Charter buses are operated by the College on behalf of families who wish to use them. Students have a reserved seat on Charter buses, therefore seat capacity is limited. The College charges families via the school fees invoicing system for charter buses.


VET

Parade College was granted Registered Training Organisation (RTO) status, registration number 40750 in October 2013. Since this time, the College has provided pre-apprenticeship and VET training to students in Years 10, 11 and 12 who are intending on pursuing post-secondary

studies either at TAFE or university; apprenticeships, or employment. Some of these courses include Certificate III Apprenticeship in Plumbing and Carpentry and various other Certificate III and IV courses.

MANCHESTER CITY FOOTBALL SCHOOL



The Manchester City Football School will provide authentic and creative football coaching program for students, utilising the coaching philosophy and methodology of Manchester City. Based at Parade College, the Football School will include a Manchester City coaching team utilising the first-class facilities of Parade College, which include FIFA accredited pitches, indoor alternatives and conditioning facilities.

The Manchester City Football School (MCFS) is a highly competitive Football School program that is offered at Parade College. Selection for this program is based on a trial performance and only students that have applied for enrolment at Parade College can trial. The primary intake for the MCFS is in Year 7. This means the application process for this process is completed when the student is in Year 5.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Parade College scholarships have been established to acknowledge and foster the development of our students with special talents and to encourage their contributions within the school and wider community. As well as being highly competitive, our academic scholarship is also an opportunity to recognise those students in our community who possess an outstanding academic record whilst also contributing actively to many facets of College life.

The number of scholarships awarded each year is dependent upon the quality of the applicants and the availability of places. All scholarships are awarded at the discretion of the Principal and are subject to annual review. Application information, including key dates and remission, is advertised on the College website.

INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC TUITION SCHOLARSHIPS

Parade College students entering Year 7 to Year 12 are invited to apply and audition for a Music Scholarship. The Music Scholarship is designed to nurture, encourage, and foster a love of music in young musicians at the school. The recipient of the Music Scholarship is expected to work hard, demonstrate leadership, and be actively involved in Music at Parade by encouraging others to engage in our dynamic and inclusive program. The Music Scholarship will be awarded to candidates who demonstrate exceptional musical ability and potential, along with enthusiasm to contribute to musical life at the College.



LOU ARTHUR MEMORIAL ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Successful applicants must have a strong commitment to their academic performance and display a desire and willingness to make a valuable contribution to the College community. Students will be required to complete the ACER HAST (Higher Ability Selection Test), and will also be assessed on their responses to application questions and supporting documentation. An interview with a panel of senior staff members for short-listed candidates is an integral part of the process of awarding scholarships.

VCE VM SCHOLARSHIPS

This scholarship is offered to new students who enrol in our VCE Vocational Major program (VCE VM) at our co-educational Preston Campus, and who demonstrate the potential to be outstanding contributors in their chosen field of interest within one of the following VCE VM Programs at Preston:

- Sport Academy
- Applied Learning Pathway















ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE WITH FEES

A variation to the level of fees payable for 2026 may be offered in cases of demonstrated financial hardship. Fee concessions are assessed by application annually. Application forms are available from the Fees Manager.

REFUND OF TUITION FEES & LEVIES

In the event of a student withdrawing from Parade College during the year, there may be an entitlement to an adjustment of fees subject to notification in writing giving one full term's notice.

- If withdrawal occurs during Term 1 –
 75% of the annual tuition fee may be refundable
- If withdrawal occurs during Term 2 50% of the annual tuition fee may be refundable
- If withdrawal occurs during Term 3 25% of the annual tuition fee may be refundable

PAYMENT OPTIONS DIRECT DEBIT INSTALMENT PLAN (from February - November 2026)

Choice of weekly, fortnightly, or monthly instalments from either Savings Account or Credit Card (all credit cards accepted). The College will automatically adjust payments in accordance with the charges levied unless advised otherwise.

Parade College offers payment by Direct Debit with various payment options to suit different family budgets. All families are expected to select an option for the payment of fees by Monday 1 December 2025. Requests for alternative payment arrangements are subject to approval.

Parents are reminded that fees are payable in accordance with our payment terms.

Parade College will impose a late payment charge for overdue instalments according to the Fee Collection Policy. Overdue accounts may ultimately be transferred to a collection agency without further notice.
