

Instrumental Music Band Class

In addition to the standard instrumental music tuition program, Parade College is excited to offer the Instrumental Music Band Class to all Year 7 & 8 students. The program is designed for Junior Musicians to receive small group instrumental music tuition and participate in a College ensemble for the cost of instrument hire and textbook charge.

Program Structure

Students enrolled in this program are formally tested to allocate them to an instrument that best suits their listening profile, embouchure and height/size. Available instruments include: Flute, Clarinet, Saxophone, Trumpet and Trombone.

Students will attend a weekly group instrumental music lesson with a specialist instrumental teacher (run during school hours on a rotating timetable) to develop their musical skills on their instrument. They will also attend a weekly ensemble rehearsal where students will play and learn valuable band playing skills with the other musicians in the program.

Students work through a set band class text (included in the complete price) and will be provided with a hire instrument to use in class and home studies.

Fees, Commitment and Expectations

The total cost of the program is a flat rate \$400 for the year, all inclusive. This is calculated at \$12.50 per lesson for 32 lessons per year, 16 per semester.

Missed lessons are not able to be made up or refunded due to the rotating class timetable and group format. Students commit to the program for the year with a non-refundable enrolment and sign an Instrument Hire Agreement form for the care of the instrument loaned.
