This unit of competency will provide you with the essential WHS/OHS knowledge and skills to work in a range of construction sites. The unit is a WorkSafe Victoria mandatory requirement for any person working on a building or construction site.

Course Entry Requirements

Course applicants must meet the following selection criteria:

- minimum 16 years of age at course commencement
- satisfactory completion of Year 9 secondary school studies or higher, and
- satisfactory completion of a language, literacy and numeracy test.

The College will facilitate the application process for the Construction Induction card (White Card) with WorkSafe Victoria once students successfully complete the unit of competency, at no additional cost to the student.

After achieving CPCCWHS1001, graduates will have OHS/WHS clearance to enter and/or work on a building and construction site.
