### Course Entry Requirements

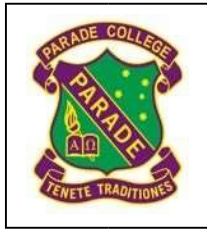
Course applicants must meet the following selection criteria:

- satisfactory completion of Year 9 secondary school studies or higher, and
- satisfactory completion of a language, literacy and numeracy test.

## Training and assessment methods, and locations

Scheduled Classes:

Training will be conducted at the Edmund Rice Trade Training Centre at Parade College, Bundoora Campus.

Assessment:

A Knowledge Test and Practical Assessment are used to assess your competence. You will receive detailed assessment information on commencement of the workshop.

## Course Requirements

You are required to wear appropriate flat heeled, closed toe shoes or boots to the workshop. No other specialist clothing, equipment or materials are required.

## Credit Transfer and Recognition of Prior Learning

Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) recognises the knowledge and skills you have gained through previous informal training, and past work and life experience.

If you think that you might be able to apply for RPL, talk to Mr McKay, Director of Trade and Training, before workshop commencement.

If you think that you might be able to apply for CT or RPL, talk to Mr McKay, Executive Officer - RTO, preferably before course commencement.

## Course Outcome

Students who satisfactorily complete all required training and assessment components of the unit will be issued with a Statement of Attainment.

The College will facilitate the application process for the Construction Induction card (White Card) with WorkSafe Victoria once students successfully complete the unit of competency, at no additional cost to the student.
