### Course Entry Requirements

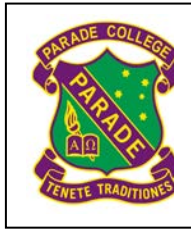
Course applicants must meet the following selection criteria:

## Training and assessment methods, and location

The course will be conducted at Parade College, Bundoora Campus.

**Training** will occur in two sequential parts.

Part 1 requires you to complete pre-course reading and a series of self-assessment questions. Required reading materials will be distributed prior to the training session.

Part 2 requires your attendance at a one day training course. The session will include trainer led presentation, trainer practical skill demonstrations, and an opportunity for you to practice these skills in a simulated environment with trainer coaching and supervision.

### Assessment:

A range of assessment methods are used throughout the course including a written test and practical skill demonstrations. You will receive detailed assessment information on commencement of the course.
