* Entry into the second year is conditional upon successful completion of all Year 11 subjects.

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Selection Criteria

Selection for the Sport Academy (VCE VM) is based on the following criteria:

- Evidence of academic ability to pursue undergraduate studies
- A desire to pursue a career in the sport industry
- Demonstrated ability in a sport at an elite level
- Previous ACC (or similar school competition) involvement and performance
- Involvement and performance in regular Physical Education classes
- General conduct and ability to demonstrate mutual respect to peers and staff
- Performance at Selection Trials
- Ability to uphold Parade College's Discipline and Uniform Policies
- Performance in local sporting competitions

Students whose application is short-listed will be required to attend an Interview.

Typical Weekly Program

- 2x ½ days of Curriculum Content: Numeracy, Literacy, Personal Development and Workrelated Skills.
- 2x ½ days of delivering skills and coaching sessions
- 1 full day of Workplace Learning OR Industry-focused projects and mentoring
- 1x ½ days of Sport: skills, squad, strength, conditioning, delivering skills/ coaching sessions.
