On Sunday 10 October 2021, Pope Francis celebrated Mass to mark the global launch of the Synod of Bishops with the theme For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation and Mission. Last Sunday, in dioceses around the world, a period of local consultation began as part of a two-year process culminating in the Synod of Bishops gathering in Rome in October 2023. The Church in Melbourne joins the rest of the world in embarking on an intentional process of mutual listening that will span two years and engage the people of God in a journey of communion, participation and mission. The Catholic Church in Australia will invite the People of God to make submissions via an online portal that opened on Monday. Those submissions will help the Bishops develop a national report to support the global process leading to an international gathering in 2023. Unit 3 and 4 Examinations and SWOT VAC Preparation

With formal classes having now concluded, Unit 3 and 4 teachers will still be available for revision in timetabled classes right up until the scheduled subject exam.

Final examination preparation can occur via MS teams or onsite at the Treacy Pavilion. Unit 3 and 4 Year 12 students should make arrangements with their individual teachers for in person tuition.

Upon commencement of the examination period, Unit 3 and 4 students should arrive at the College no more than 30 minutes before the commencement of their exam. Students are to sign in at student reception and then make their way to Westcourt Walk in preparation for the commencement of their examination. A presentation on VCAA exam rules was shown to the students in their final week and is available on SIMON under 'Student Links'.

Year 11 Written Examinations

As advised in the last College *Newsletter*, the dates for upcoming Year 11 examinations are 10 to 18 November.

NAPLAN School Readiness Test – Wednesday 17 November

The College will be completing NAPLAN online in 2022. In order to prepare for this, all schools making the transition to online testing are required to complete the NAPLAN Schools Readiness Test in Term 4 of this year. As part of the School Readiness Test (SRT) process, all Year 7 and 9 students will be required to participate in two separate online tests using their school laptops on Wednesday 17 November. Students will need to bring headphones that connect to their school laptop on this date in order to complete each test. Student data is not collected or reported on as part of the SRT.

School TV can be found on our website and through our PAM system.


